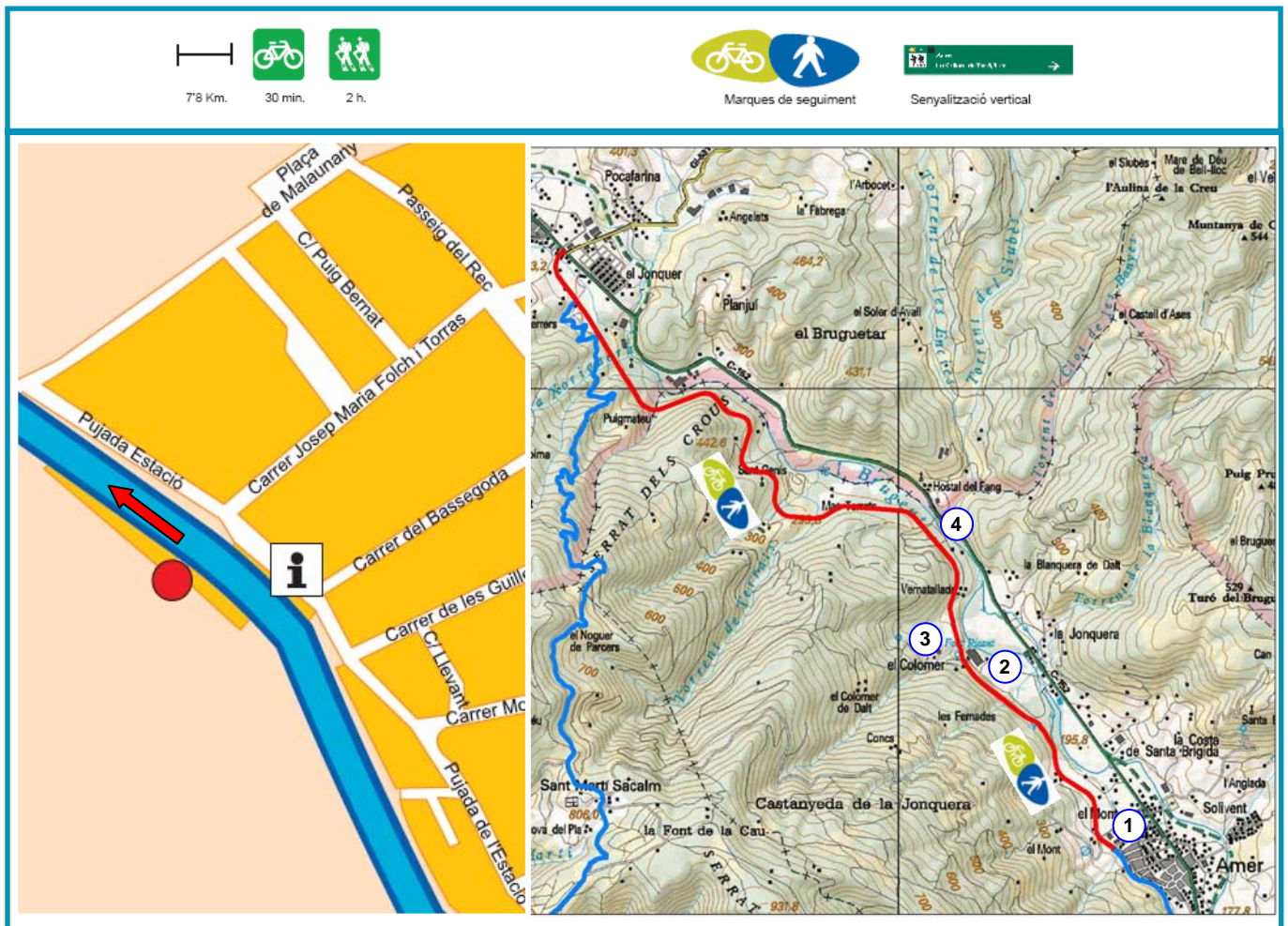


## Amer - Les Planes d'Hostoles: "From river to mountain"



The route begins at the Amer's old narrow-gauge **railway station (1)**, which has been restored, and is now a Tourist Information Office. The car parks are located near the office and there are also boards showing, in detail, the different routes that start at Amer.

We follow the Greeway, which was the former narrow-gauge railway line, and which we will continue along for the entire route, first going north-west, following the old line that formerly ran between Girona and Olot. This is a well-signposted path, and is suitable for everyone - it can be travelled on foot, by bike and on adapted bikes.

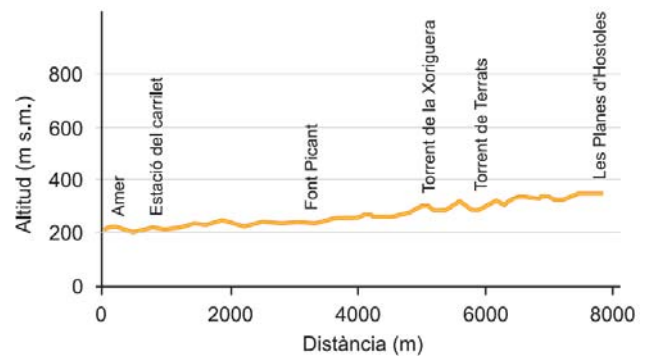


Some 3 km from the starting point, we will see on our right **La Font Picant (2)**, which is well known as a place where sparkling water is bottled.

We will also find signs that indicate a path that leads to Colomer, where we can see the church of **Sant Marçal de Colomer (3)**

From here we find several sections of the route where the path passes over wooden bridges or areas where the old railway had been dug right out of the mountain (4).



From here the path leads us on through the valley of the river Brugent to Les Planes d'Hostoles, a town that belongs to the Garrotxa region. Here we will find rest areas, and everything we need for a good meal
